June 2007 – VTB Delivery & installation scheduled for the 60th Military Airlift Wing, at Travis AFB, CA. The Virtual Terrain Board will be used for initial and annual pilot refresher training. Installation includes customized mission preview software modules for three airfields in South West Asia.

New VTB Runtime Software Version 2.0 Upgrade. The VTB’s new runtime software version 2.0 now includes Illumination, Lighting, and Shadow modules. In addition, new databases, special effects, and the MenuCube™ on-screen control application are included for more accurate and versatile NVG training. The runtime 2.0 software is a core component of the standard VTB package. All previously fielded VTB systems are currently receiving software upgrades.
